In October of 2022 the Missions Team approved support for a new ministry called *TeacHaiti*. Founded in 2007 by Miquette D. McMahon, a long-time friend of Stephanie Kuiken, the ministry

empowers Haitian children to emerge from poverty through education.

Don lost his wife, Gail, to cancer in 2018. Though he has officially retired from his position at Missionary Retreat Fellowship, he plans to stay on as a volunteer to serve this important ministry.
